### Keauhou Bay-Wet-n-Wild Kayak Cave/Snorkel Tour (This is the best tour for CRUISE SHIP CLIENTELE that are on a limited time frame)

Check-in at our store for outfitting and orientation followed by a short drive to the launching facility from our shop. We launch kayaks roughly 1 hour after check-in. You will be launched out of the well protected Keauhou Bay on the South end of Alii Drive in Kailua-Kona, Hawaii. Keauhou Bay, the birthplace of King Kamehameha The Third (Kau'ikeauoli), is a busy commercial port but was once a mellow Hawaiian village. We will escort you south out of Keauhou where you will have the opportunity to see Turtles, Dolphins and Whales (during season) as you paddle along the way. We will paddle south to a series of large Lava Tube Caves nestled inside the cliffs of Kuamo'o Bay used by Hawaiians for many purposes and see the graves of fallen warriors at the Ancient Hawaiian Battlefields of Kuamo'o Bay. You will snorkel on a small

coral reef with a good array of tropical fish for a half an hour or so. We will also do cliff jumping (Ancient sport - Lele Kawa) off the top of towering cliffs, which you will be able to try. At your own risk of course! Tons of Fun!

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# Tips to consider when making reservation:

Kealakekua Bay - This tour is considered one of our premier tours and the easiest of all the tours that we offer. The kayaking is mild impact and offers the longest snorkeling time of all our tours. Group sizes average 10 - 12 persons for this tour during busy seasons. This tour is good for people ages 2 - 82 with very light impact on your body! 3.5 hr. afternoon tours available for this area daily.

Stand Up Paddle Board - This water sport takes the freedom of kayaking and the excitement of surfing and combines them for an exhilarating ocean experience! Take an introduction SUP lesson or one of our SUP Snorkel Adventures. You will have the opportunity to paddle around historical sites and over gorgeous coral landscapes teeming with colorful tropical fish. Call or email for lesson or tour times and availability.

#### Keauhou Bay (Best tour for cruise ship clientele)

This is the closest port to Kailua-Kona town and the Kailua Pier. This is an open ocean tour along the coastline and probably the most difficult paddling area of all our tours but still very do-able. This tour has very minimal snorkeling compared to our other tours. Tours average 8 - 24 people during busy seasons.
